+ Library

The Library of the Museum of Vietnamese History (Ho Chi Minh City), formerly a library of the Agricultural and Industrial Committee of Cochin China, (*Comité agricole et industriel de la Cochinchine, 1865-1883*) and the Library of the Society of Indochinese Studies (Bibliothèque de la Société des Etudes indochinoises, 1883-1975) (SEI Library), was officially established in 1883 as the earliest established library in the South of Vietnam.

The SEI library has the role of "bringing together all the works related to Indochina and its neighboring countries." The library's collections are rabundant and diverse, including precious and rare materials, whose two main types are books and magazines, mainly in French. The library only serves SEI members, and it is run independently with the funds contributed by its members and sponsors.

On August 23, 1979, the Museum of Vietnamese History (Ho Chi Minh City) was officially established, receiving artifacts from the National Museum of Vietnam in Saigon (1956-1975) and the SEI. The SEI library was then renamed into The Library of the Museum of Vietnamese History (Ho Chi Minh City).
